

RULES AND POLICIES FOR THE 2019 CHAMPIONSHIP MEET

1. No changes will be made to a team's entries once the Heat Sheet has been posted on the web site (www.amymsa.org). Exceptions will be made if it was an obvious mistake submitted on the original entry time (example: seed time of 1:45 for the 1000 free should have been entered in the 100 free). NO CHANGES OR CORRECTIONS CAN BE MADE AFTER MIDNIGHT ON TUESDAY, MARCH 19.
2. All swimmers must compete in the same age-group for the entire season, including the Championship Meet. The swimmer's age is determined by his/her age on December 31, 2018.
3. The number of swimmers on a team entered in the Championship Meet will determine the Division that team competes in at the Championship Meet. The number of swimmers will be the number of swimmers **registered** for the Championship Meet, not the number that actually compete.
4. A swimmer may compete in seven (7) individual events plus two (2) relay events for the Championship Meet. A swimmer may swim all his/her individual events on one day, or divide them any way he/she chooses over the two day meet. As this is a team competition Meet, you are encouraged to swim seven (7) events so the team will receive the maximum number of points (7-5-4-3-2-1).
5. A relay team is permitted to change the individual swimmers in a relay, as long as the change **DOES NOT** change the age-group in which that relay was registered.
6. If there is a problem or question with a swimmer's time, the Team Rep should see the Secretary or "helpers". Times will become official twenty (20) minutes after the results have been posted.
